1. Granting of non-exclusive rights

I hereby irrevocably grant the Otto-von-Guericke University Magdeburg, performing organizational unit: University Library (UL), unlimited in time and space, the non-exclusive right with regard to the work

- for electronic storage, in particular in databases,
- to make the work available to the public in international data networks (§ 31 para. 2 German copyright law),
- for conversion for the purpose of long-term archiving or visualization, taking into account the preservation of the content (the original archiving remains intact),
- to modify and/or complete the supplied metadata, if necessary,

- to pass on the work and the associated metadata to the German National Library, Open Archives Initiative, as well as other document servers and specialist databases with the same aforementioned rights that are relevant to the subject or region.

The right of use applies to all known and not yet known types of use.

I will provide the data to the UL in a format suitable for the publication of the work. The format and the preliminary services are set out in the "Information sheet for the electronic publishing of a publication via the server Share_it". I have acknowledged the information sheet.

I retain my copyright and the unrestricted right to publish and reuse the work elsewhere.

I acknowledge that by making the work available on the server Share_it, users are entitled to use my work free of charge in accordance with the applicable copyright law (§ 53 German copyright law).

2. Rights of Third Parties

I confirm that the work, including illustrations etc., does not violate statutory provisions, official orders or other rights of third parties, in particular their copyrights and personal rights.

I also confirm that I alone am entitled to dispose of the copyrighted rights of use to the aforementioned work and that I have not yet made any disposition contrary to the granting of rights in accordance with Section 1. Should I become aware of the existence or emergence of legal obstacles, I will inform the UL immediately.


If I have previously published the work in whole or in part (e.g., cumulative thesis), I am obliged to clarify the exploitation rights of third parties (e.g., publishers) or to obtain their consent.

I commit myself to indemnify the UL against claims arising from legal or official infringements and in the event of the assertion of third-party rights in relation to the work.

The UL is entitled to block access to the publication or to partially or completely delete the data record on which the publication is based if there are concrete indications of an infringement of third-party rights or if other legal regulations require this.

As the author, I am solely responsible for the content of this work. The UL assumes no liability for the content of the work provided and linked or embedded external sites.

The right of use granted may be transferred in whole or in part to third parties and non-exclusive rights of use may be granted to other repositories or a third party may be commissioned to provide the publication without the need for my separate consent.

Information sheet for the electronic publishing of a publication via the server Share_it

The full-text version of the publication is published on the basis of the server Share_it in the electronic exchange format PDF/A, which is made available in the OPAC of the University Library of the Otto-von-Guericke University Magdeburg and through an automatic notification to the German National Library.

The following requirements must be observed when submitting the file:

- The file must not have any password and/or copy protection.
- The following metadata regarding the content of the publication must be submitted in both German and English in Word or PDF format:
 - an abstract of max. 1,000 characters (incl. spaces) for each language;
 - a maximum of ten keywords per language.
- Relevant personal information or information linked to a personal date should be removed. The pagination of the publication must not be changed as a result. Removal after publication is not possible.
- For dissertation and habilitation thesis, the electronic version in PDF/A format must match the printed version.
- For dissertation and habilitation thesis, a printed and bound copy - hardcover binding and printed on age-resistant, wood- and acid-free paper - must also be submitted.

Additional regulations for cumulative theses:

- The declarations of consent from the publisher(s) for the publication of the whole or parts of the work are to be enclosed with the granting of a deposit license.
- If parts of the work are not covered by a declaration of consent, they must be replaced by a link to the full text and/or an abstract. The pagination of the publication may not be changed as a result.
- If full texts are replaced by a link and/or an abstract, the electronic version is no longer identical in content to the printed copy. In this case, two additional bound copies must be submitted to the UL for the German National Library in addition to the above-mentioned print copy in accordance with the Ordinance on the Compulsory Submission of Media Works⁴.
